- 5 T: Oh you went to a park? Nice. What did you do there? Did you play on swings?
- 6 S1 (silent)
- 7 T Do you know what swings are? They are like hanging chairs. You can go back and forth.
- 8 S1 No, I play ball.
- 9 T I see. You played balls at the park.

- 11 T How do we say 足球 in English? Does anyone know the English word for 足球?
- 12 S2 Soccer!
- 13 T That's right! Soccer is 足球. So what did Mark do yesterday?
